

INTENT TO
PARTICIPATE IN AN
OFF-SITE EVENT FORM

No later than the 20th day of the month preceding the off-site event, the holder of an off-site permit shall notify the Maryland Alcohol, Tobacco, and Cannabis Commission of its intention to attend an off-site event. The permit holder is also required to notify the local licensing board of the jurisdiction in which the Farmers Market or non-profit festival will be held. For Distillery off-site permit holders only: while selling liquor or providing samples of liquor at an event, the permit holder shall have present at least one individual who is certified by an approved alcohol awareness program.
